2019-2020 Goals

<u>Goal #1</u> Student Reading Inventory lexile scores will increase 2% from the baseline test in the fall of 2019 to the post test in spring 2020.

<u>Goal #2</u> In the area of whole school growth in Mathematics, the 7th and 8th grade median statewide student growth percentile (MGP) rank will be increased by 3 points.

<u>Goal #3</u> In the area of whole school growth in Science, the 7th and 8th grade median statewide student growth percentile (MGP) rank will be increased by 3 points.

<u>Goal #4</u> 80% of students enrolled in Chinese Dual Language Immersion courses will show proficiency of Intermediate Low for 7th grade and Intermediate Mid for 8th grade.

<u>Goal #5</u> Increase participation and achievement in district-wide and state-wide music festivals.

2020-2021 Goals

<u>Goal #1</u> 7th grade students will increase their math proficiency as demonstrated by a 5 point Median Growth Percentile (MGP) on the RISE assessment, raising the score from 55-60.

<u>Goal #2</u> 8th grade students in the subgroup of Special Education will increase their math proficiency as demonstrated by an 8 point Median Growth Percentile (MGP) on the RISE assessment, raising the score from 42-50.

<u>Goal #3</u> English Language Learners (ELL) in grades 7, 8, & 9 will increase their language arts proficiency as demonstrated by a Median Growth Percentile (MGP) of 60 on the RISE or Aspire+ assessment.

<u>Goal #4</u> 75% of 8th grade students enrolled in Chinese Dual Language Immersion courses will show proficiency of Intermediate Mid in all areas (Reading, Speaking, and Writing) of the AAPPL test.

<u>Goal #5</u> Improve sense of community and safety for students and staff by implementing SEL strategies as measured by the SEL Walkthrough Tool and a school-created survey
