 - Not all subjects tested
 - Not all students are testing
 - Core classes show competency
- GOAL 2: SPED and ELL (English Language Learners) subgroups will increase %age of students proficient by 2%
 - ELL
 - Increase number of proficient students. WIDA test
 - Offering classes to help. Certified ELL teacher and grouped by WIDA scores where they need help. Gives English credit and extra help.
 - SPED
 - End of level test scores low proficiency
 - Improve by looking at individual students
 - Students with IEPs (Individualized Education Plan) are considered SPED
