School Improvement Plan Review and Discussion

Deanne – Discussed school improvement plan in joint staff school committee this last Friday. They were able give some input on the plan.

Reviewed "Needs Analysis" – a few items still need to be added to certain sub-sections. Statistics need to be reviewed and added. "Land Trust Funding Projections" 2017-2018 - less than 10% carry over of budget from 2017-2018 to 2018-2019 school year.

Goals for the 2018-2019 school year –

Goal #1 – (increase MGP in Science) implementing of blended learning practices in the up and coming year. Teachers will read the book "Bold School". Canvas will be used more heavily in

the next year. Richard – expressed need for more specificity in action plan for increasing canvas use. Agreed that school will find a way to make canvas use among teachers measurable.

USTAR Funds – school is looking to add 1 ½ productivity staff for Math or Science in order to reduce class sizes in Math and Science.

Asked if the school needs more money for to hire more staff to cover productivity.

Goal #2 - (Increase MPG in Math) action plans are essentially the same as for Goal #1.

Goal #3 – (Increase MPG in Language Arts) – Actions plans are essentially the same for Goals #1 and #2. Introduction and integration of MEMBEAN Software in English Classes.

Possible 4th goal proposed. – Implementation of Bell Choir in fin arts. Requested spending of funds on more bells so more students can take the class. Expressed that those extra bells are a 3rd priority to technology and productivity.

Review of proposed 2018-2019 budget.

Rob Hunter- suggested we try to have less carry over from last year. Agreed that that money should be used on hiring more productivity.
